This responds to your August 12, 2005, letter to the Southeast Region of NOAA's National Marine Fisheries Service concerning the draft final regional restoration plan to facilitate restoration of resources injured by oil spills in southeast Louisiana. NOAA and various resource trustees of the State of Louisiana prepared the document. Proposed therein is a process by which essential fish habitat (EFH) documentation would be included in individual Damage Assessment and Restoration Plans prepared on an incident specific basis. This is to advise you that we agree with your opinion that this EFH consultation mechanism would be consistent with the coordination requirements of the Magnuson-Stevens Fishery Conservation and Management Act and its implementing rule.
